

From Our Kitchen to Yours:

Fudge Cupcakes

- 4 semi-sweet chocolate squares
- 2 sticks margarine
- 1 c. chopped nuts (Pecans or Walnuts)
- 4 eggs
- 1 c. flour
- 1 34 c. sugar
- 1 tsp. vanilla

Fill cupcake liners halfway. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Bake for 18-21 minutes, or until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean. Allow to cool completely before frosting. Yields about 14.

Fill mini liners only halfway and bake for 10-12 minutes at 350°F (177°C). Yields about 3 dozen.
